

Privacy Policy: A Law Requirement

As we have previously stated, displaying privacy policy agreements for websites that use web visitors' information is mandatory by law. That is because the collected data can be used to identify an individual who has visited the site.

There are several states and federal laws in the USA that have provisions on data privacy:

- The California Consumer Protection Act of 2020
- The Computer Security Act of 1997
- The Consumer Credit Reporting Control Act
- The Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1986
- The Americans With Disability Act
- The Children's Internet Protection Act of 2001 (last updated in 2013)
- The Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984

Additionally, you have to get familiar with the laws and acts in the state where you reside. For instance, the State of California has the CCPA in place among others.
